B – Collaboration and Negotiation	The delegate resists compromise and lacks initiative, hindering collective progress. The delegate actively collaborates and contributes constructively but occasionally depends on others to lead negotiations.	The delegate collaborates effectively by integrating diverse opinions and negotiating well, though proposals may need refinement. C — Leadership	The delegate lacks leadership, resulting in disjointed debate.
